- **Cleaning refers to the removal of germs, dirt, and impurities from surfaces. It does not kill germs, but by removing them, it lowers their numbers and the risk of spreading infection.**
- **Disinfecting refers to using chemicals, for example, EPA-registered disinfectants, to kill germs on surfaces. This process does not necessarily clean dirty surfaces or remove germs, but by killing germs on a surface *after* cleaning, it can further lower the risk of spreading infection.**

- **Our Multi-surface Disinfectant Cleaner: Is an EPA-registered disinfectant that kill germs on surfaces such as; Staphylocidal, Pseudomonacidal, Bactericidal, Salmonellacidal, Fungicidal and Virucidal.**

## How to clean and disinfect

- Wear disposable gloves when cleaning and disinfecting surfaces. Gloves should be discarded after each cleaning. If reusable gloves are used, those gloves should be dedicated for cleaning and disinfection of surfaces for COVID-19 and should not be used for other purposes. Clean hands immediately after gloves are removed,
  - If no gloves are used when handling dirt, trash, etc., be sure to wash hands afterwards.
  - If possible, do not shake dirt and trash. This will minimize the possibility of dispersing virus through the air.
  - Launder towels, rags and cleaning cloths as appropriate in accordance with the manufacturer's instructions
  - If possible, launder items using the warmest appropriate water setting for the items and dry items completely.
